## **The Top 5 . . .**

### **Important Information Needed for the KY FirstNet Work Packets**

#### **1) THE FUTURE EFFECTIVENESS OF PUBLIC SAFETY IN KY –**

It's important to know about gaps in LMR or commercial coverage in your jurisdiction, but we also need your requirements for the future data network! Based on the proposed baseline coverage in the Work Packet:

- \*Where do you need signal tomorrow?
- \*What locations/buildings in your jurisdiction may need better coverage?
- \*What locations have poor coverage today and need better coverage tomorrow?

#### **2) COMPLETE ALL SECTIONS OF THE DOCUMENT - CHECK THE BOXES IN THE WORK PACKET –**

The Work Packet asks you for a lot of info! You are on the team to help Kentucky build a better communications network for the future! To plan for the future starts with your input – please work through the entire Work Packet and check the boxes on page 2 when you complete each section.

#### **3) MAP INPUT-- LOCATION PLEASE! –**

The *BEST* information about Kentucky is always local. You are the key to getting it right! We need location info when you see things on the map that are wrong. Give us your input in the Work Packet by:

- Writing back about what's wrong
- Making an edit on the map / making your own map
- Photocopying one of your local maps and highlighting the areas to change

Whichever way you decide, be sure you identify *what* is wrong and exactly *where*....

#### **4) DON'T FORGET THE BUILDINGS & USERS IN YOUR JURISDICTION –**

In the Work Packets we received already, many first responders told us about missing buildings and agency personnel. This where your input makes a difference!

#### **5) UNDER-REPORTING OF COMMERCIAL PHONE/DATA SERVICES OR USE OF PERSONAL DEVICES –**

The Work Packet info you send to KSP is for planning the user requirements and capacity needs for the future -- and nothing else. Under reporting may result in higher cost to jurisdictions in Kentucky and could result in building a network with inadequate capacity. Please gather all of this info to help us plan for what's ahead and design a network that meets your needs!
