## PSAC Consultation – Working Groups



- Early Builder Strategies and Lessons Learned
  - Working Group conference calls held in December 2014 and January 2015
  - Members developed recommendations that FirstNet will be able to incorporate into the network design and implementation
  - New tasking issued in February focuses on deliverables related to formal key learning conditions and informal key lessons
- Tribal Outreach, Education, and Consultation Strategies
  - Working Group conference call held in January 2015 and an in person meeting in February 2015
  - Members developed several recommendations that FirstNet will be able to incorporate into its tribal engagement efforts and requested continuation of the Working Group

## PSAC Consultation – New Assignments



- Priority and Preemption Task Team Kicked Off 2/26
  - FirstNet is seeking advice from PSAC regarding an initial framework for implementing access prioritization, user preemption, and prioritized application use in the nationwide public safety broadband network (NPSBN)
- Public Safety Grade (PSG) Task Team Kicked Off 2/27
  - FirstNet is seeking advice from PSAC regarding an initial methodology and Framework for implementing PSG elements in the NPSBN with respect to priority needs, critical infrastructure protection, and geographic and human threats
- User Equipment Kicked Off 3/4
  - FirstNet is seeking advice from PSAC on functional objectives for and ergonomic considerations of Band 14 broadband user equipment that will meet the operational needs of first responders

- Submitted to Congress on March 3, 2015
- Provides comprehensive update on:
  - Progress toward strategic goals
  - Partnerships with local, state, tribal, and federal jurisdictions

  - FirstNet resources and operations





### **Second Public Notice**



- The FirstNet Board voted to release a second public notice seeking comments on certain legislative interpretations under the Act relating to key topics including:
  - Technical Requirements for Equipment Use on the Network
  - Network Policies
  - State Plan Implementation and Decision Process
  - Customer, Operational, and Funding Considerations Regarding State Assumption of Responsibility to Build and Operate a RAN
- The public, including any individual or organization, is invited to submit written comments to the notice either electronically through <a href="www.regulations.gov">www.regulations.gov</a> or by mail to the address listed in the notice
- The comment period for this notice closes April 28,2015

### Technical Requirements for Equipment Use on the Network



### The Act

 FirstNet must "promote competition in the equipment market place by requiring for devices used on the network to be built to open, non-proprietary, commercially available standards..."

### **Notice Interpretations**

- Applies to any equipment, including end user devices, used "on" (i.e., to use or access) the network
- Applies whether or not the equipment is to access the network via a FirstNet or state deployed radio access network
- Applies only to parameters necessary to ensure "interoperability"

### **Network Policies**



### The Act

 FirstNet must establish network policies in carrying out its duties and responsibilities to deploy the network


### **Notice Interpretations**

- Policies developed apply either directly or indirectly to States that seek to conduct their own RAN deployment
- A State's demonstrations of interoperability is a commitment to adhere to FirstNet's interoperability policies
- Compliance with network policies is essential to the deployment and interoperable operation of the network and will be a condition of entering into a spectrum capacity lease
- States, during consultation, will have substantial opportunities to influence the network policies

### Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012



"Upon the completion of the request for proposal process...the First Responder Network Authority shall provide to the Governor of each State, or his designee—


- (A) notice of the completion of the request for proposal process;
- (B) details of the proposed plan for buildout of the nationwide, interoperable broadband network in such State ("State Plan"); and
- (C) the funding level for the State as determined by the NTIA."

### **State Plan Process**



### Under the Act, the Governor has 90 days to choose whether to


- 1. Participate in the FirstNet proposed radio access network (RAN) deployment or
- 2. Assume responsibility to conduct its own state RAN deployment



### State Participation in FirstNet Proposed RAN



- Governor chooses to accept the deployment of the RAN as proposed by FirstNet
- FirstNet is responsible for RAN deployment, including the building, operation, and maintenance of the State RAN
- The State's public safety entities will be responsible for paying user fees for the FirstNet service, if they adopt the service





### **State Conducted RAN Deployment**



The state must notify FirstNet, National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA), and the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) of its decision to deploy a RAN and then:

#### **Complete RFPs within 180 days**

• For statewide RAN construction, maintenance, and operation

#### **Develop alternative State plan for RAN deployment**

Must meet minimal interoperability requirements


#### FCC reviews alternative State plan

- <u>Disapproved</u> Network deployment follows FirstNet proposed plan
- <u>Approved</u>— State may apply to NTIA for a grant for RAN construction, but must apply to lease spectrum capacity

### If approved, apply to NTIA to lease FirstNet spectrum capacity

- Must demonstrate "cost-effectiveness" of state plan
- Must show comparable completion timelines, security, coverage, and quality of service to that of the nationwide public safety broadband network (NPSBN)

#### Pay fees to use FirstNet core





## Customer, Operational and Funding Considerations Regarding State Assumption of RAN Construction and Operation



### **Key Network Considerations**

- FirstNet must consider the potential effects in and outside of a State on public safety customers.
- FirstNet's costs and available funding nationally, including its ability to meet substantial rural milestones, and the purchasing power of FirstNet on behalf of public safety.
- FirstNet and States must in all cases define and implement a potentially complex operational relationship to serve public safety.

### **Customer Relationships**



### The Act

 Does not expressly define which customer-facing roles are assumed by a State or FirstNet with respect to public safety entities in States that have assumed responsibility for RAN construction and operation

### **Notice Interpretations**

- FirstNet preliminarily concludes that the Act provides sufficient flexibility to accommodate a variety of different arrangements so long as the interoperability and self-sustainment goals of the Act are met
- FirstNet's preliminary interpretations leave to discussions on a state-by-state basis the specific implementation of service provision in such States

### FirstNet Funding



### FirstNet is a Zero-Sum Game

- Fees = Costs
- All FirstNet fees are reinvested to construct, maintain, operate, or improve the nationwide network




## The State Equation: Cost to Serve ≅ Density of Population















#### **Radio Resource Allocation Priority**



Expected to see High Priority Establishments take precedence over Normal Priority during congestion. Preliminary results have not shown expected outcome.

#### **Data Bearer Allocation Priority**




Expected to see High Priority Data Bearers take precedence over Normal Priority during congestion. Preliminary results confirm expected outcome.

Testing and Evaluation Continues to Provide FirstNet with Valuable Data

## **PSCR Modeling and Simulation**




- Use LA-RICS site plan to evaluate high power resiliency strategy:
  - Set E-UTRAN Node B (eNodeB) to high power (FCC limit)
  - Compare with different user equipment (UE) powers 0.2W and 1.2W
  - Vary network outage from 0 to 75%
  - Compare indoor versus outdoor environments
- During a network outage, in order to maintain 95% coverage, the overall network throughput is reduced.
- Using high power-UEs can significantly improve the sustainable throughput
- Certain outage scenarios up to twice as much sustainable throughput can be achieved.

 Public Safety managed mobile virtual private network (MVPN) might prevent QoS, Priority, Pre-emption from operating at the application level









Most States and Public Safety
 Entities are not familiar with the relationship between "per-Gigabyte" pricing for Public Safety Users and the need for pre-pay/ Intelligent Network/Online Charging-based billing systems to support the pricing





 FirstNet will not be immune to risk associated with delays due to public outcry over network build/new towers





 In general, initial early builder networks do not have robust network performance, device, service reporting, or Operations, Administration, and Management (OA&M) platforms included





- Relatively short life cycle of LTE equipment makes upgrades and technology replacement costly
  - Important to understand in the context of a multi-year network deployment schedule for the NPSBN
