- The KWIEC is supported by Working Groups








- KSP chose a region in SE KY to perform a detailed review of coverage requirements:

Commonwealth of KY – Regional Coverage Pilot: OEC Baseline













Commonwealth of KY – Regional Coverage Pilot: All Levels






Commonwealth of KY - Regional Coverage Pilot: Commercial LTE







Example 1:

In-Building/Handheld Coverage

- Coverage provided to a handheld device through minimum one wall.
- OEC coverage baseline includes all Urban Areas and Clusters (UA and UC) within Kentucky as defined by the US Census Bureau (> 1,000 people per square mile)

Feedback

Madisonville Fire Dept.- In-building coverage in the north-west quadrant west of Peewee Lake should be increased due to high concentration of industrial complex structures and high probability of incidents involving interior operations in manufacturing facilities

Handheld/Partial In-Building Coverage

- Coverage provided to a device outdoors or "on the street" including some inbuilding coverage
- OEC coverage baseline made up of Census Designated Places (CDP) outside of Urban Areas and Clusters with more than 500 people

Feedback

Madisonville Fire Dept.- The white block within the incorporated limits of the city of Madisonville north-east of Peewee Lake should be changed to Handheld/Partial in building coverage due to possible future expansion of residential areas surrounding this location, and its proximity to the college campus.






