- The KWIEC is supported by Working Groups

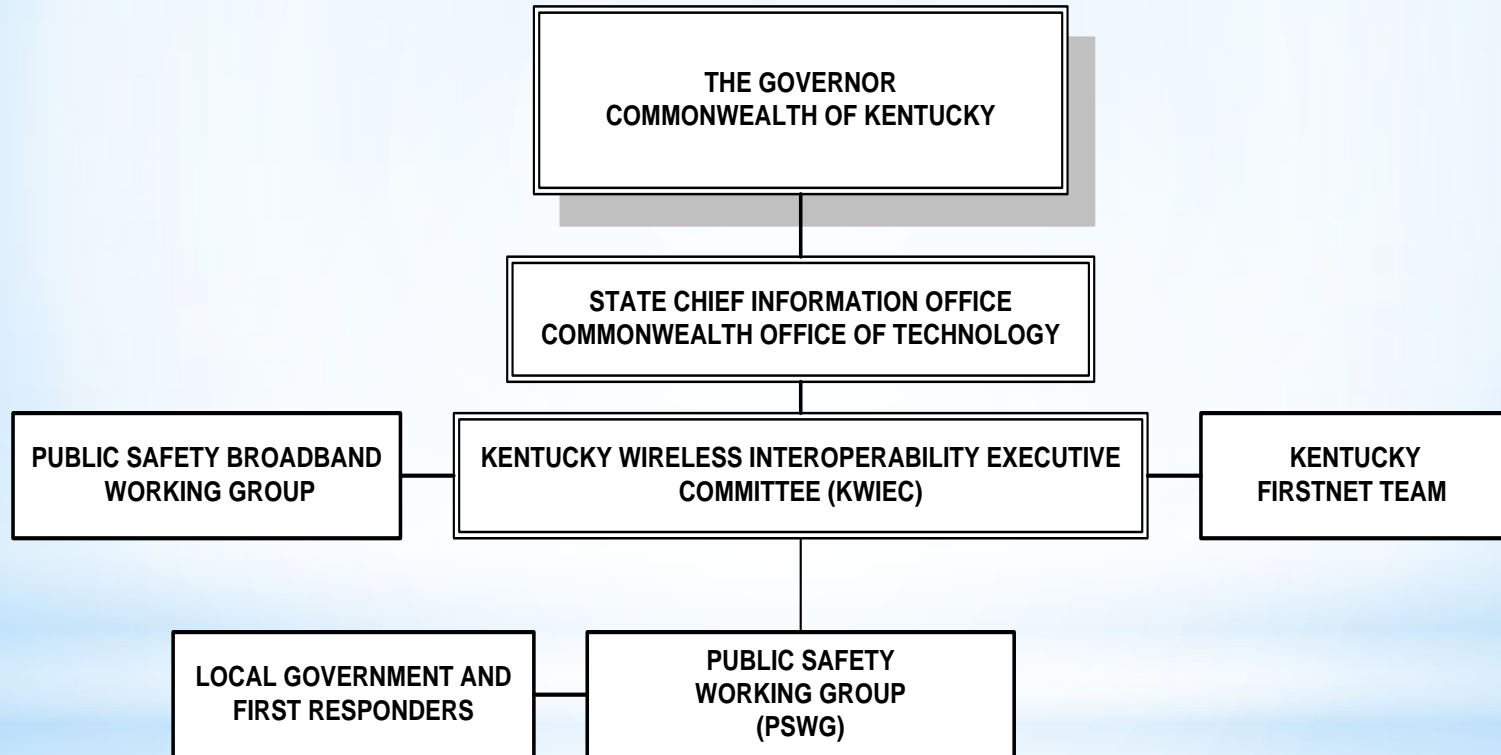

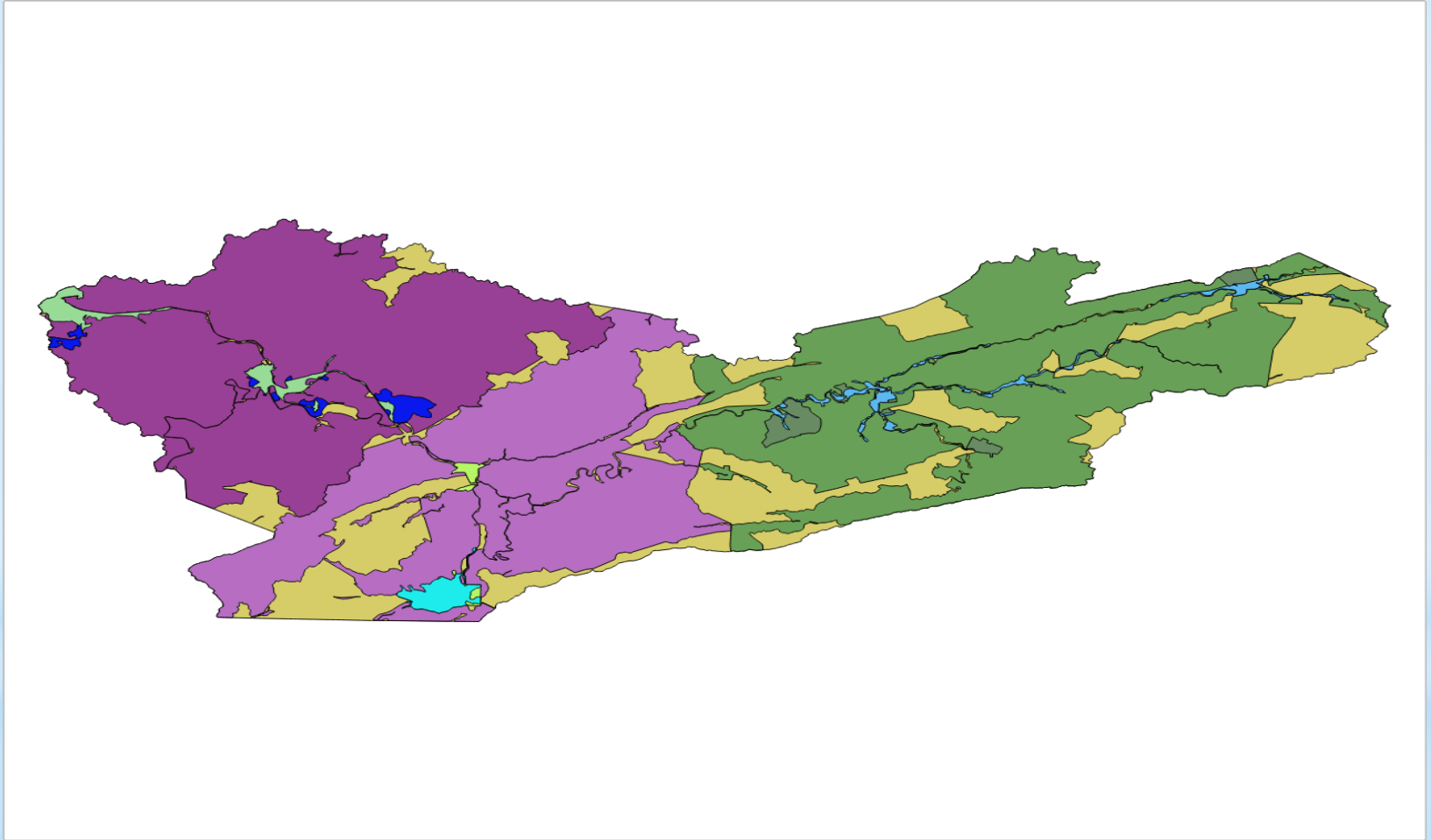
Commonwealth of KY – *Regional Coverage Pilot*

 - Review existing commercial coverage.

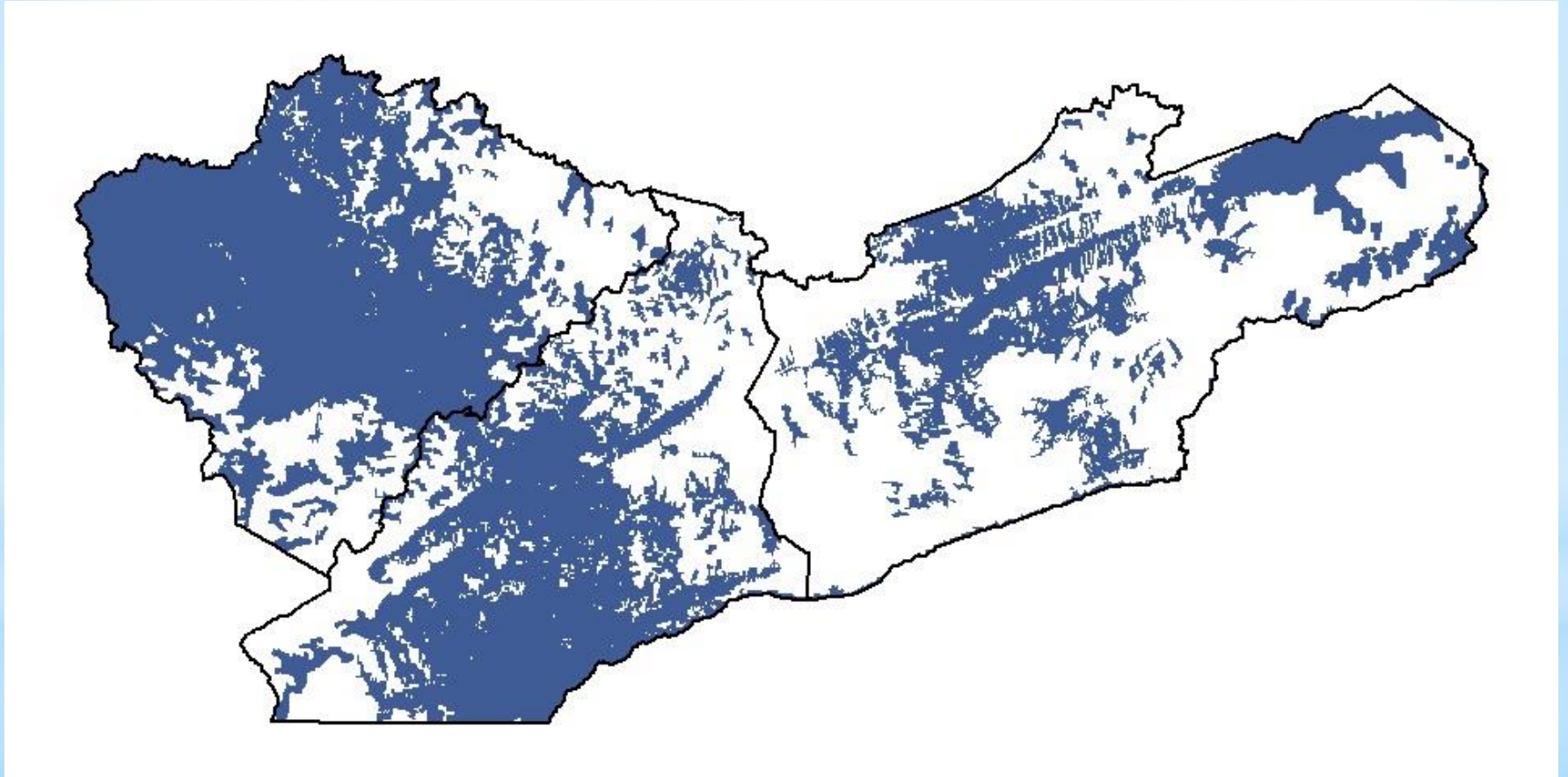
Commonwealth of KY – *Regional Coverage Pilot: OEC Baseline*



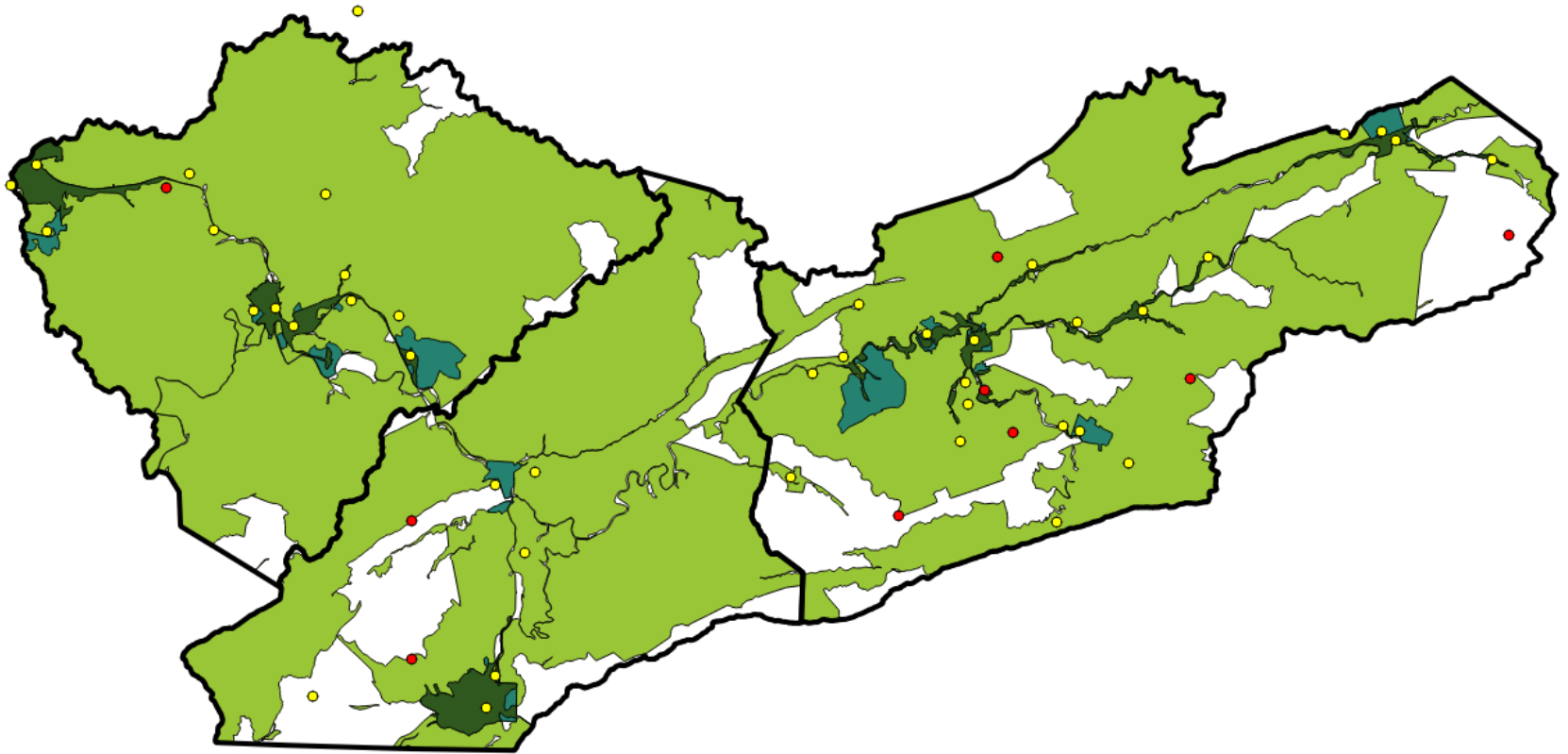
Commonwealth of KY – *Regional Coverage Pilot: All Levels*



Commonwealth of KY - *Regional Coverage Pilot: Commercial LTE*

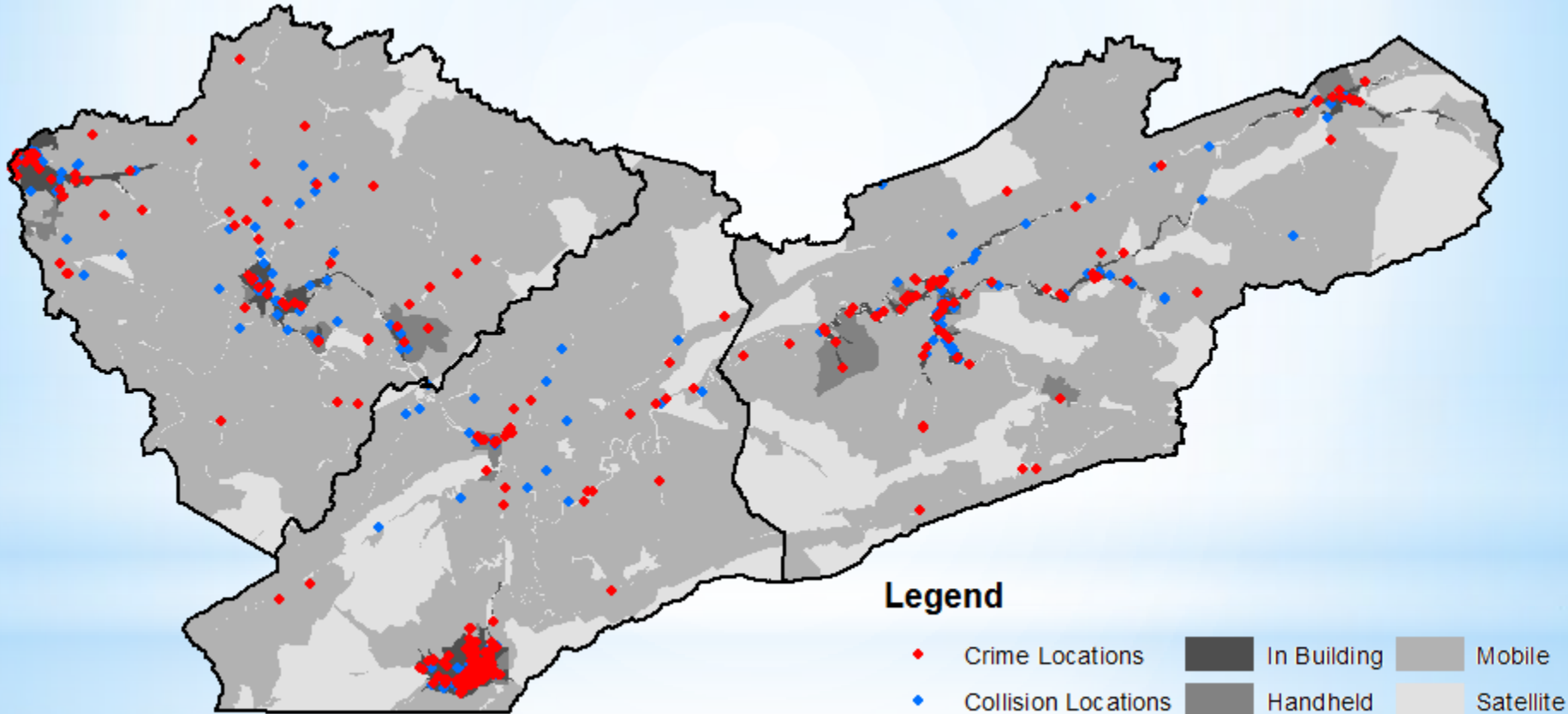


Commonwealth of KY - *Regional Coverage Pilot: Sites*



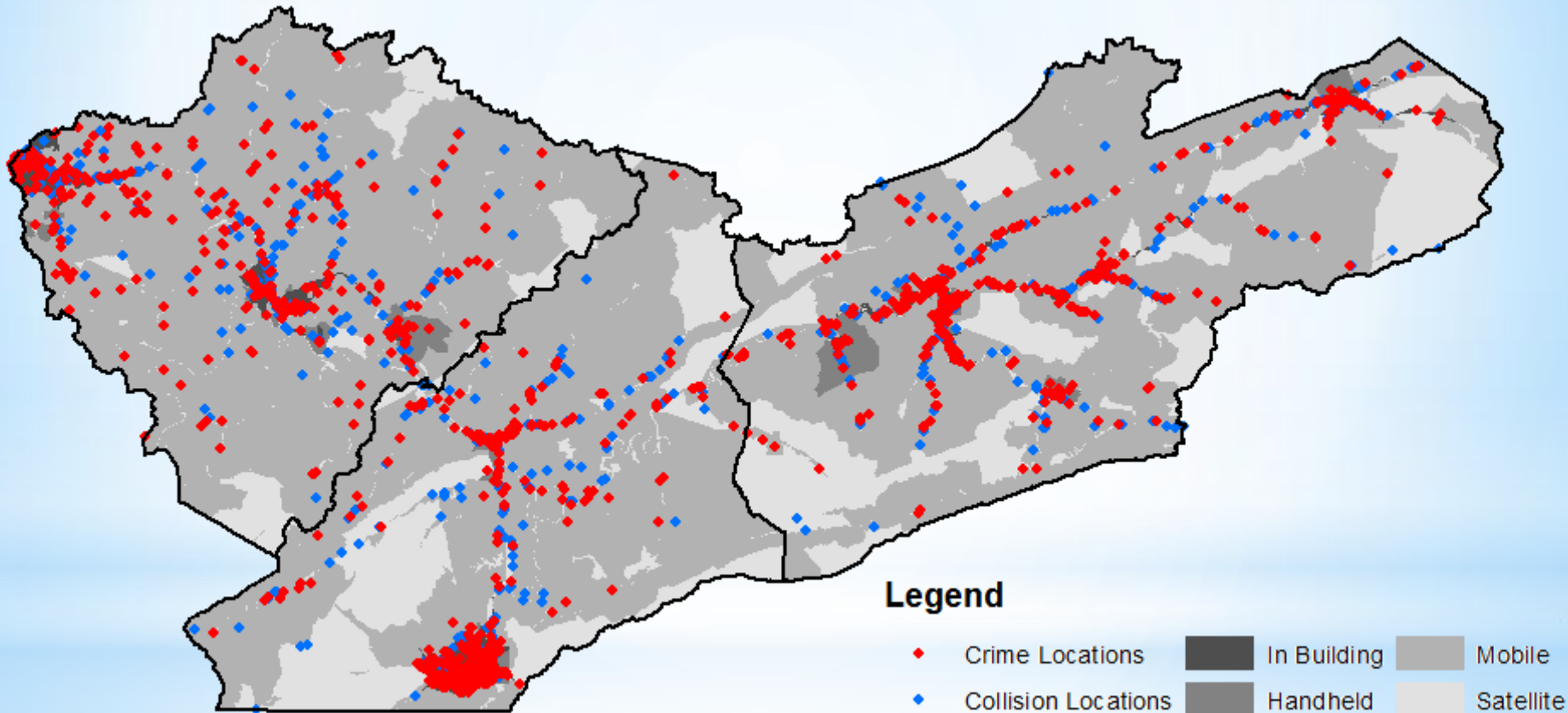

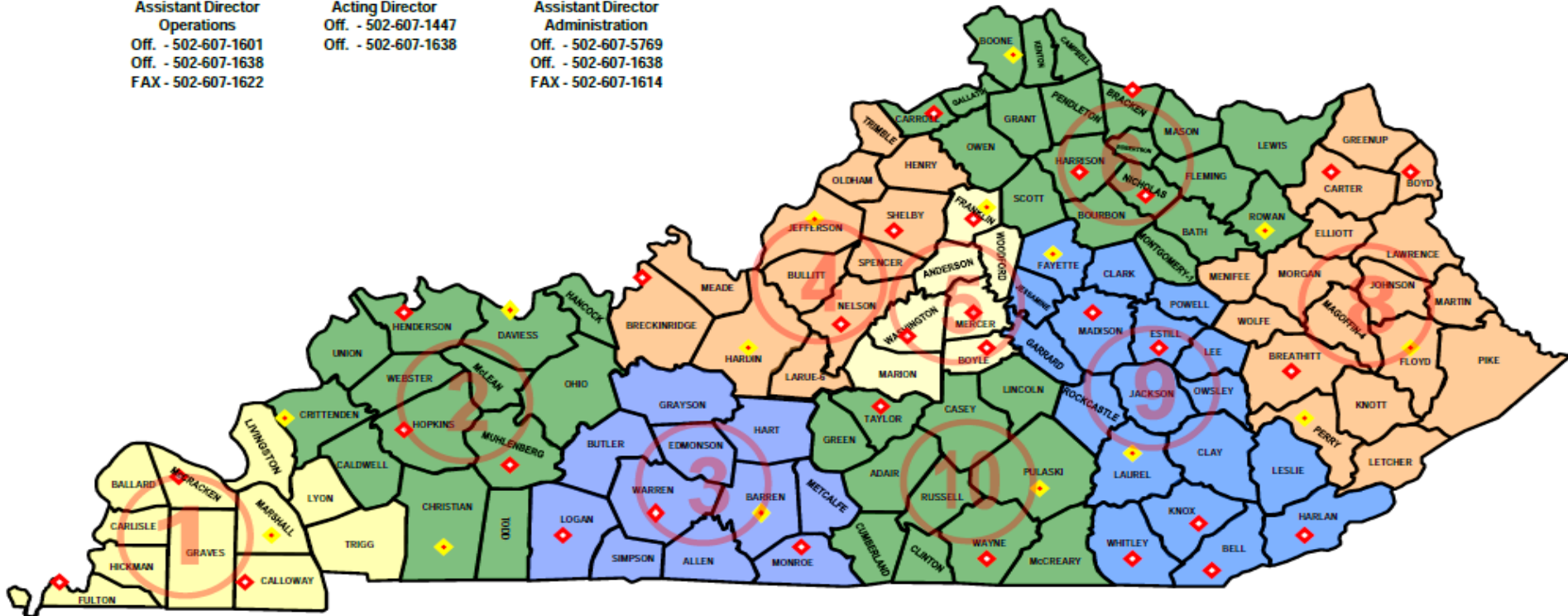
